Al-Khidmat Foundation Pakistan

Situation:

Flood started on 28th July 2010 in different areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and later on 18 districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 9 district of Punjab, 5 districts of Sindh, 7 districts of Baluchistan and 5 districts of AJK were involved. Now on 4th August 44 districts out of 123 districts of Pakistan (114 Pakistan 5 AJK & 4 Gilgit) are in severe flood.

Launching of Flood Relief Activities:

12,110 Volunteer Workers in Action

Flood areas became water locked and most of the areas were disconnected from other parts of the Country.

Effected parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa were totally disconnected from other parts of the Country. Motorway Connecting Peshawar and Islamabad was damaged and was blocked for any traffic for four days. Similarly G.T Road and Railway Track remain blocked for five days.

The strength of Al-Khidmat Foundation having its organization and devoted workers at almost every corner of the country was very useful in this particular situation. Local organizations of Al-Khidmat Foundation launched relief activities immediately after flood with their local resources.

They utilized their funds and collected donations locally and commenced relief activities within hours of flood. These locally generated activities later on received support from provincial and central offices of Al-Khidmat.

At the moment 12,110 volunteer workers of Al-Khidmat Foundation are working day and night in different flood effected areas of Pakistan.







Rescue Activities:

18,720 Lives Saved

First target was to rescue people and save human lives. Al-Khidmat volunteers used all available resources and conducted rescue activities.

Al-Khidmat Foundation bows its head to Allah (SWT), who gave the opportunity and strength to save lives of more than 18,720 people. This activity was carried out by available boats, tubes and ropes.

At one place Al-Khidmat workers used a long rope and 1500 persons walked few hundred meters in the water by holding this rope. These people were facing real life threat.













De-Watering Pumps:

12 Dewatering Pumps are in Action

12 dewatering pumps are in action to drain out the water from basements and houses with low ground levels at different place.

Relief Camps:

74 Relief Camps in Action

Al-Khidmat established relief camps in almost all effected areas. According to the information on 4th August 74 Relief camps are actively working in different parts of the country.





Cooked Food & Drinking Water Supply:

Cooked Food delivered to 82,900 Persons

Most of the displaced people are living in water locked areas and are deprived of food and water.

Al-Khidmat started distribution of cooked food and drinking water to these effected people on daily basis.

So far 82,900 persons have been provided with cooked food. Cost of cooked food ranges from Rs. 3000/to Rs 4000 per pot (DAG) which is sufficient for about 75 persons.

Similarly thousands of bottles of drinking water were distributed to flood effected people.







Donate Rs 3500 to provide cooked food to 75 persons

Water Filteration Plant:

Installation of Water Filtration Plant 50,000 liters per day

Installation of a Water Fileration plant at Nowshera is in the process which will provide filtered drinking water at the rate of 50,000 liters per day.





Repair of Water Pumps and Cleaning of Wells:

Teams are ready to be sent to repair water pumps and clean the wells at different areas.

Water Tanks for Drinking Water:

15 Water Tanks Moving

15 Water Tanks are moving to different areas for supply of clean drinking water to the people who are deprived of clean water due to flood.

Shelters:

20 Residential Camps in different areas.

Al-Khidmat established 20 residential camps in different areas to provided temporary accommodation to flood effected people.

Many buildings and 480 Tents have been used for this purpose. So for approximately 8000 persons are accommodated in shelter camps.

Transportation to safe areas:

332 Vehicles managed to Transport 55,000 persons

Workers of Al-Khidmat by the help of 332 vehicles managed to transport 55,000 persons to safe areas.







Food Packages:

15,330 Food Packages distributed

Dry food packages are distributed among those displaced families who have cooking facilities. These food items are sufficient for 10 days, for a medium size family.

Medical Relief:

75 Medical camps, 24,180 Patients treated

52 Ambulance in Action

Al-Khidmat initiated Medical Relief activities from the day one of flood. Mobile dispensaries equipped with medicine and manned with doctors and paramedics are sent to different parts of the flood hit areas.

Al-Khidmat is also collaborating with Pakistan Islamic Medical Association in this field.

Till date 65 medical camps are conducted in 33 places in which 24180 patients were examined by 52 doctors.

95 paramedics and other support staff have participated in this activity.

52 Ambulance are active in flood hit areas.

We are planning to send more ambulances and doctors to the effected areas.

Cost of one Mobile Clinic is around Rs.20,000 per day which examines are treat 200 patients on average.
