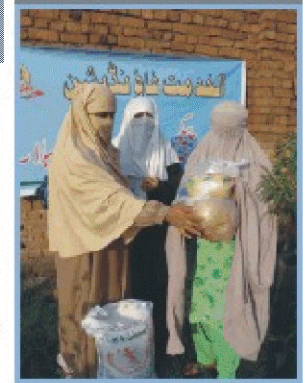

Rehabilitation Programme

In selected areas where water level has dropped, Al-Khidmat Foundation commenced rehabilitation programme. The following programmes are on top priority.

- * Construction of damaged houses
- * Medical / Maternity facilities
- * Water filtration plants
- * Self employment programme including live stock development
- * Livestock development
- * Agricultural inputs for farmers. Provision of seeds, fertilizes, inputs to farmers.
- * Interest free loans, grants to revive small businesses

Maternity Hospital in Flood-hit areas:

3% of the populations affected by violent floods are female at mature stage of pregnancy (estimated around 600,000) in affected area ready to give birth within next weeks. With broken infrastructure, survival of new born and mother are in danger.

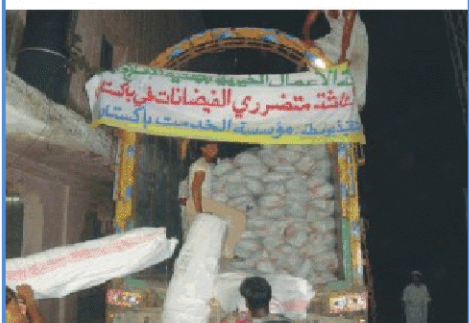
Tent villages:

Donate US 5,000/- for Two Rooms House

Established Small Tent villages (50 tents) in affected districts, these tent villages secured with boundary wire. Al-Khidmat is responsible for their Food, Filtered Water, Medicines, education of kids and security arrangements.

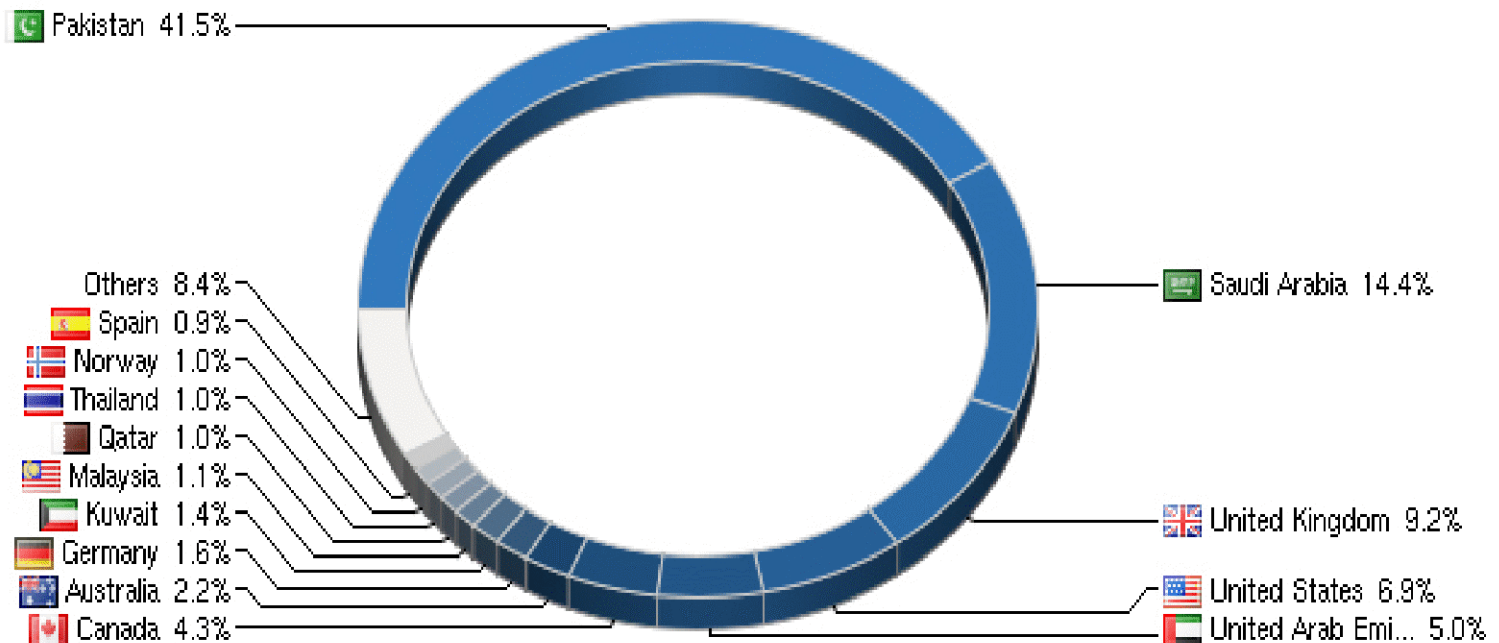

Launching of Flood Relief Activities:

24,011 Volunteer Workers in Action

24,011 volunteer workers of Al-Khidmat Foundation are working day and night in different flood affected areas of Pakistan.

Rescue Activities:

97,436 Lives Saved

First target was to rescue people and save human lives. Al-Khidmat volunteers used all available resources and conducted rescue activities.

Al-Khidmat Foundation bows its head to Allah (SWT), who gave the opportunity and strength to save lives of more than 97,436 people. This activity was carried out by available boats, tubes and ropes.

De-Watering Pumps:

35 Dewatering Pumps are in Action

35 dewatering pumps are in action to drain out the water from basements and houses with low ground levels at different places.

Relief Camps:

961 Relief Camps in Action

Al-Khidmat established relief camps in almost all effected areas. 961 Relief camps are actively working in different parts of the country.



Medical Relief:

476 Medical camps, 2,75,392 Patients

Al-Khidmat initiated Medical Relief activities from the day one of flood. Mobile dispensaries equipped with medicine and manned with doctors and paramedics are sent to different parts of the flood hit areas.

Al-Khidmat is also collaborating with Pakistan Islamic Medical Association in this field.

Till date 476 medical camps are conducted in 164 places in which 2,75,392 patients were examined by 630 doctors.

1175 paramedics and other support staff have participated in this activities.

Cooked Food & Drinking Water Supply :

Cooked Food delivered to 14,44,430 Persons

Most of the displaced people are living in water logged areas and are deprived of food and water.

Al-Khidmat started distribution of cooked food and drinking water to these effected people on daily basis.

So far 14,44,430 persons have been provided with cooked food. Cost of cooked food ranges from Rs. 3000/- to Rs 4000 per pot (DAG) which is sufficient for about 75 persons.

Similarly thousands of bottles of mineral water were distributed to flood effected people.



Food Packages:

4,57,970 Food Packages distributed

Dry food packages are distributed among those displaced families who have cooking facilities. These food items are sufficient for 10 days, for a medium size family.



Donate Rs 3500 to provide cooked food to 75 persons

Following **DRY FOOD PACKAGE** is estimated to be sufficient for 10 days for a medium size family (5 to 7 persons).

Water Filtration Plant:

Installation of Water Filtration Plant 50,000 liters per day

Installation of a Water Filtration plant at Nowshera is in the process which will provide filtered drinking water at the rate of 50,000 liters per day.

Another **16 FILTRATION PLANTS** have been donated by **PAKISTAN ASSOCIATION DUBAI**.

Repair of Water Pumps and Cleaning of Wells:

Teams are regularly sent to repair water pumps and clean the wells at different areas.

Water Tankers for Drinking Water:

56 Water Tankers Moving

56 Water Tankers are moving to different areas for supply of clean drinking water to the people who are deprived of clean water due to flood.

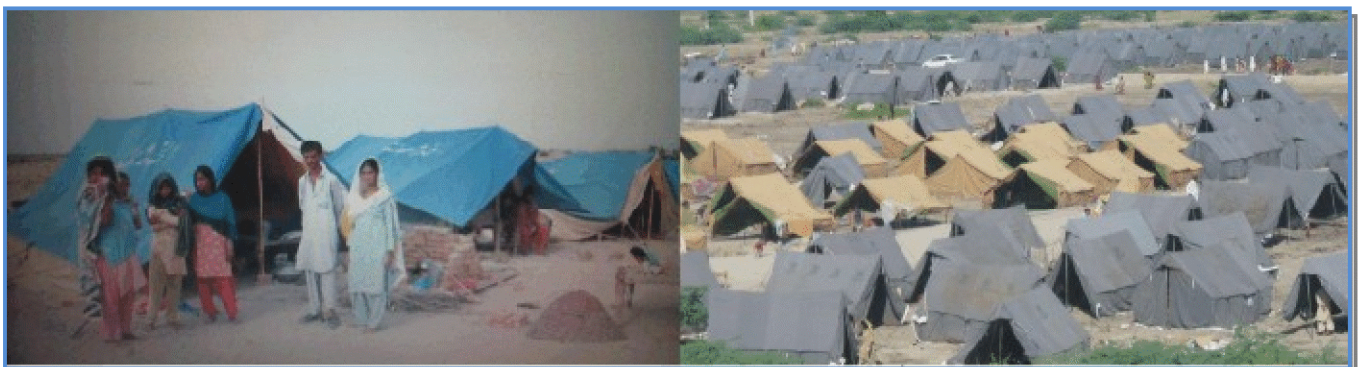


Shelters:

88 Residential Camps in different areas.

Al-Khidmat established 88 residential camps in different areas to provide temporary accommodation to flood affected people.

Many buildings and 3900 Tents have been used for this purpose. So for approximately 39500 persons have been accommodated in camps.



Cost of one Tent 6,000, sufficient for 8 to 10 persons

Transportation to safe areas:

417 Vehicles managed to Transport 82,000 persons

Workers of Al-Khidmat by the help of 356 vehicles managed to transport 82,000 persons to safe areas.

Cost of one Mobile Clinic is around Rs.20,000 per day which examines and treat 200 patients on average.
