SOMALIA

Nutrition Centers

On November of 2011 Doctors Worldwide opened up two Nutrition Centers located in the region of Hodan and Lafole. The purpose of these centers is to provide medical treatment and therapeutic food to the malnutrition population in the area. With the project until now 10.000 individuals were given medical treatment and 12.800 boxes of baby formula were distributed.

So far a total of 12000 children have been examined, 2085 have been admitted in Supplementary Food Program (SFP) and 1210 have been admitted in Outpatient Therapeutic Program.

The Lafole and Hodan Nutrition Centre projects came to an end on November 2012.

On May 2012, DWWT opened its third nutrition center in Towfiq area of Yaqshid district in partnership with IMANA and UNICEF. DWWT provides therapeutic food and basic health care to up to 9000 children and mothers living in the Yaqshid area. DWWT follows a strong community based therapeutic care component program with a strong focus on mother/child relationship.

Somalia Shifa Hospital Project

On March of 2012 , Mogadishu Shifa hospital was opened with the sponsorship of Medical Park Health Group was .Shifa hospital with its 68 bed capacity is furnished with the most modern equipment.

The hospital has 2 Operating Theatre, 3 Table Delivery Room, Biochemistry, Hematology, Microbiology Laboratory, Radiology Department, Men and Women Internal Disease Services, Surgical Services, Infections, Maternal, Newborn & Child Services, Maternity Services, Internal Diseases, General Surgery and Family Medicine.

On November 2011, Future health personnel of our Shifa Hospital came to Istanbul to undertake an intensive training for 7 weeks. The personnel were 9 physicians, 3 nurses and a laboratory physician followed a rotational program including pediatrics, maternity care, emergency and surgery.

Al-Shifa hospital on average gives service monthly to more than 4500 people; it serves as the only hospital in Somalia that gives service to the 1/3 of the population.
