



IMANA Medical Relief Report 2012

Asalamualakum My Dear Brothers,

I hope this report finds you all in the best of IMAN and health. Below you will find a detailed report regarding our activities for 2012.

1. IMANA Relief –

The name and logo were changed. IMANA remains the central organization while our relief activities will be under IMANA Medical Relief

2. SaveSyria –

In collaboration with our brothers in Lebanon. IMR transported \$50,000 worth of medical supplies into Homs in March of 2012

3. SaveHaiti -

IMR revisited Haiti this past year. In collaboration with a Muslim organization, "The Read Foundation" IMR established the Haiti Outpatient Establishment Clinic. Outside Port au Prince is a city called Miragone. Miragone is situated approximately three hours west of the capital. Health care remains non-existent with a surrounding population of approximately 350,000. IMR, has been supporting local physicians in staffing the clinic while every three months sending a team of physicians and nurses from the United States. Our teams have treated well over 5,000 patients this past year alone.

IMR's goal is to eventually secure enough funding so that a Hospital can be built for this community.

4. SaveSmile -

IMR traveled to Sudan in march. This was our third annual trip. Once again the lives of 158 children were changed forever. Our SaveSmile mission focuses on children afflicted with cleft lips and palates.

5. <u>SaveVan</u> – IMR joined forces with Doctors WorldWide "Turkey" in funding a mobile basic health unit. This mobile BHU served those who were affected by the Van earthquake. Thousands received free health care over the first six months of 2012. IMR forwarded \$40,000 for this project.

6. SaveSomalia -

IMR made several attempts to establish continuous medical missions to Mogadishu after their visit in 2011. Unfortunately the realities of civil war did not allow for a sustained effort. Subsequently IMR and DWW Turkey worked together in establishing a nutrition center in Mogadishu. The center serves both inpatient and outpatients. IMR helped by funding \$125,000 for this center. Thousands have been served at this center since its opening.

7. Pakistan Flood Relief -

IMR has remained involved in Pakistan since the early days of the flood. IMR has been working closely with PIMA and Pakistan Kidney Institute (Dr. Saeed Akther) in various ongoing projects.

- <u>IMANA-PIMA Women's and Child Mobile Clinic</u> IMR forwarded funding in the sum of \$40,000 for the clinic in early 2012
- <u>Dera Ghazi Khan Basic Health Center</u> IMR forwarded \$100,000 in 2012 for the center.
- <u>Rajunpur Thalassemia Center</u> In collaboration with Pakistan Kidney Institute, IMR established a Thalassemia center in this area of Pakistan which is endemic for this disease. Rajunpur was severely affected by the devastating floods leaving the local hospitals incapable of serving this population patients with this blood disorder. IMR forwarded \$30,000 for the yearly budget.

8. IMANA Diabetic Hospital Nokhali Bangladesh -

IMR has been working with Bangladeshi NGO in the construction of a hospital in rural Nokhali. The hospital officially opened in July of 2012. IMR funded well over \$100,000 for this project and continues to financially support this center. This past year IMR funded over \$40,000 in new medical equipment for the hospital.

9. <u>IMANA Village</u> –

Following the devastating earthquakes of 2005, in northern Pakistan. IMR adopted a village, now known as IMANA Village in collaboration with Al-Khidmat foundation. IMR has been assisting with funding for this village since. IMR forwarded \$20,000 for the yearly budget.

10. IMR Ramadan Live Telethon -

IMR hosted a live televised national telethon on a satellite TV channel this Ramadan. We were able to showcase our work to a national Muslim audience and expand our donor network by doing so.

11. Newtown School Shooting -

IMR immediately released funding in the sum of \$5,000 for crisis intervention counseling following the horrific tragedy that took place at the Sandy Hook Elementary school in Connecticut.
