



MALAYSIA HIT BY WORST FLOODS, THOUSANDS HOMELESS AND IN NEED OF ESSENTIALS COMMODITIES. IMARET RESPONDS PROMPTLY

East coast of Malaysia and b south eastern provinces in Thailand faced the worst monsoon floods witnessed after so many decades. At least six states were badly affected. More than 150,000 people were displaced from their homes, hospitals remained non functional following the electricity failure but most tragically thousands of Malaysian young and old are somewhere out there, wet, cold.

In close collaboration with Islamic Medical Association of Malaysia (IMAM) and its partners, IMARET (Islamic Medical Association Response and Relief Team) responded swiftly to the unprecedented devastation. Our partners include MERCY Malaysia, Ikram Health, I-Bantu,

Team #tamakpahala, MIMPA, and countless generous individuals.

Since 23rd December 2014, twelve teams have been deployed to the states of Terengganu and Kelantan. Five cargo loads of medical supplies and basic necessities including drinking water, hygiene packs and food were airlifted to these states. Airlines namely Firely, Malindo Air and AirAsia have sponsored the flights of all our doctors and supplies.

More than 100 young doctors, nurses and allied health professionals have already served and matching number is on a standby and more than one ton of medical supplies have been distributed so far.

FIMA will respond with both financial and emergency humanitarian relief aid from local







surrounding regions (Indonesia, Pakistan, Australia, etc). Dr Zaim (+60 12 760 3514) was appointed the local coordinator in Malaysia (see contact details below and banking details). IMA LEBANON CAMPAIGN AGAINST POLIO, MEASLES & RUBELLA ERADICATION

IMALB had participated in National campaigns in collaboration with the Ministry of Public Health and Ministry of Social Affairs and the Ministry of National Education, Civil Society and the medical society and with the support of UNICEF and WHO. The implemented campaigns were mandatory.

IMALB executed the vaccination campaigns against Polio in Al Rayan Medical Center, in schools,

in mosques, on Streets, etc..

Phase I: March 10-15 against Polio, Measles and Rubella with vitamin A dose

Phase II: April 10-15 against Polio, Measles and Rubella with vitamin A dose

National campaigns for vaccination of children dropping out from previous campaigns:

from 15 to 21 July, 2014

from 15 to 21 August, 2014

from 15 to 21 September, 2014

Phase III: October 15-21 Polio

Phase IV: November 15-21 Polio




The book provides unique and comprehensive expert discussions on various types of addition, including (Behavioral Addiction), with Islamic perspectives.
