32nd FIMA COUNCIL & FIMA-IMANI-MUKISI SCIENTIFIC MEETINGS CONCLUDES IN MAKASSAR, INDONESIA

Truly historic and very well attended FIMA meetings were held in the beautiful city of Makassar, Indonesia this week, the capital of South Sulawesi Island in Indonesia jointly hosted by Universtas Muslim Indonesia, IMA of Indonesia, MUKISI and FOKI. The meetings were preceded by an eye camp conducted by FIMA Save-vision in collaboration with the local host Dr Silhati at Ibne Sina Hospital in Makassar.

The pre-council meeting of FIMA executive committee was held on 11th August. Prior to the exco meeting, the delegates were taken to UMI boarding school, where the new entrant medical students to UMI are kept for around 6 weeks before start of their medical career. They are taught with Quranic teachings, Hadith, salat, medical ethics, sports, physical fitness training etc and they get familiarized with each other, thus developing a deep rooted bond of brotherhood and sisterhood. Dr. Syarifuddin on behalf of the host IMA welcomed the delegates. A resolution was approved for preparation of a comprehensive document to assess the past and present status of FIMA and to prepare a tangible and doable future action plan.
