IMANA RELIEF RECIEVES THE PRESTIGIOUS ACP - AWARD 2016

The most respected national award of Richard and Hinda Rosenthal foundation was given to Dr. Ismail Mehr, IMANA Medical Relief Chairperson for meritorious services rendered by IMANARelief in the area of humanitarian and medical relief from the American College of Physicians (ACP). Dr. Mehr accepted the award on behalf of IMANA at the 2016 ACP Internal Medicine Meeting held recently in Washington, D.C.

The Richard and Hinda Rosenthal Award from The Rosenthal Family Foundation was established in 1976. It is given "to that organization whose innovative designs of facilities (such as hospitals, intensive care units, or clinics) improve clinical care or the economics of care."

IMANA President Dr Asif Malik thanked the previous IMANA Relief Committee chairs, Dr. Ayman Rayes (MI) and Dr. Hafiz Rehman (NY), as



2nd TURKISH ARAB CONFERENCE ON HIGHER EDUCATION HELD IN ISTANBUL UNDER THE AUSPICES OF MEDENIYET UNIVERISTY

The Medeniyet University in Istanbul organized the 2nd Turkish Arab congress on higher education. The event attracted a large number of academicians and faculty head from Turkey, Arab countries and members of CIMCO (Consortium of Islamic Medical Colleges) of FIMA (Federation of Islamic Medical Associations). President of Turkey Mr. Recep Tayyip Erdogan addressed the concluding session and gala dinner of the very successful congress. There were 507 participants belonging to 190 universities from 19 countries including 10 CIMCO members. 90 Memos of understanding were signed between Medeniyet University and foreign universities.

President Erdogan in his historic presidential speech expressed his gratitude and congratulated the organizers from Istanbul Medeniyet University for holding such a well arranged and successful congress.

President Erdogan urged the

academicians and heads of the Universities to contribute to the development of cooperation in the field of education, "We, all of us, share a common geography and a common civilization, common history and we share a common culture. Our history has continued to be an example to all the humanity for centuries as the beacon of light and resource for the bases of research in Science, astronomy, mathematics, philosophy and other disciplines. He said that we are custodians of a magnificent civilization in the past Andalusia, Baghdad, Africa, the Middle East and Asia with a lost glorious civilizations.

He said the history can furnish a testimony to the grandeur and glory of Islamic civilization, as the city libraries and madrasas were visited by scholars from all over the world. He quoted that in the 11th century, when Europe was shrouded in dark medieval period, there were 75 universities in Cairo, 51 in Damascus and 44 in Aleppo alone with thousands of students studying there from all over the

then known world including Europe.

He said that due to decline of Islamic civilization and failure to enter the new era of excellence in education and leaving the pace with emergence of technology our countries led to the catastrophe and disintegration.


He added that Turkey is very keen to have educational collaboration and exchange of knowledge and technology with Arab world especially in the areas of cooperation in higher education and development of institutions.

He said that Turkey is opening the avenues of higher education to all the world and around 15 000 Arab students from Syria, Iraq, Palestine, Libya, Somalia, Yemen, Jordan, Morocco, and Egypt etc. are presently studying in Turkey. The total number of international students in our country goes to 75 thousand. There is a tremendous increase in the number of the new students, however we still look forward to accept more and more









students in the area of higher education and technology.



HEALTHY GUIDELINES DURING RAMADHAAN
