- 4. ICU Monitoring devices
- 5. Surgical instruments and Orthopedic accessories (rods, screws...)
- 6. IV Pulls
- 7. Stretchers, Wheelchairs and Crutches
- 8. Oxygen tanks
- 9. Sterile drapes, gowns, sheets, pillows (w cases)and blankets
- 10. Medical waste disposals
- 11. Pain Meds PO, IV, Anastasia and antibiotics

We would like to emphasize that most of the medical care offered at HAIMER Haiti's hospital has been provided by US trained professionals from our partners such as NOAH-NY, IMANA and others.
