FIMA CONCERNED OVER SHORTAGE OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES IN GAZZA AND APPEALS FOR MEDICAL RELIEF

The recent Israel-Palestinian conflict resulted in huge loss to human lives, property and establishments. The Palestinian death toll exceeded 250 including a number of innocent women and children.

In wake of urgent call for medical relief, FIMA and member IMAs planned to help the destitute and a meeting of FIMA executive committee was convened (online). The meeting was attended by FIMA office bearers, executive members and Dr. Abdul Qadir, director of Palestinian health authority (in Gazza), who appraised of the healthcare situation arising from wide scale escalation and bombing which resulted in civilian causalities and told that the already compromised healthcare infrastructure was overburdened, if not collapsed.

The existing paucity of healthcare services for the people in Gazza and west bank are known and hardly meet the minimum standards, there is a

Sorry to bring a sad news about the passing of our brother Dr Hussain Nagamia over the weekend in Tampa, Florida, USA.


Dr Nagamia was an international figure in the history of Islamic Medicine.






