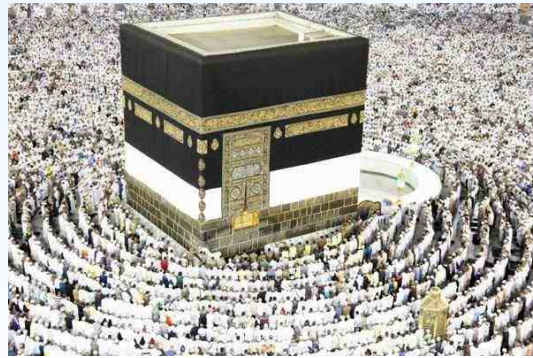

FIMA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETS IN MAKKAH, KSA

This time the meeting agenda was made different; the exco went for a short workshop on strategic planning. 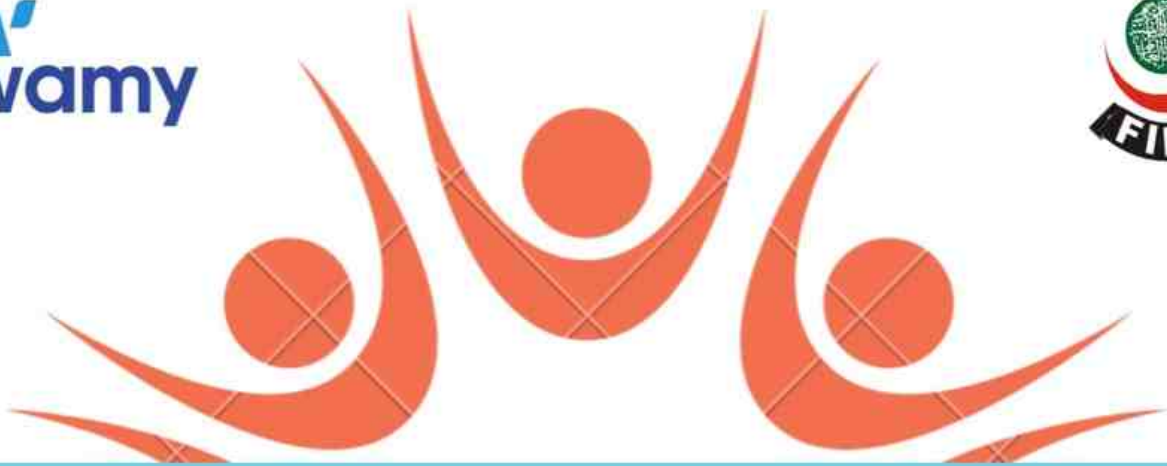
