MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

LARGEST EVER EYE CAMP HELD IN KABUL, AFGHANISTAN UNDER THE AUSPICES OF POB, PIMA, FIMA SAVE-VISION & AL-KHIDMAT

A history making and large scale eye camp was held in Noor eye Hospital, Kabul under the auspices of POB, PIMA, FIMA Save-Vision and Al-Khidmat. A total number of around 5000 patients was examined and a record number of 1350 surgeries were done with a spectrum of intraocular lens implant, oculoplasty and vitero-retinal surgery. High end equipment amounting to Rs 30 million was donated including sophisticated equipment for Vitero-retinal surgery, phaco-emulsification and disposables. The visit was coordinated by Pak Afghan cooperation forum.

A number of 18 eye surgeons, nursing and allied staff were there for a week; these included a professor of Vitero-retinal surgery and a renowned professor of oculoplasty. Three other professors and a few consultants

were also there. The infrastructure was there but the expertise of local surgeons needs further reinforcement and improvement in sophisticated techniques. Training session for local eye surgeons were also held alongside and hands on training was also conducted. There is hardly any arrangement for corneal transplant in war torn Afghanistan. Al-Khidmat and POB is considering

starting a corneal transplant unit in Noor eye Hospital, Kabul.

The group of doctors was very well received by the local team and a formal meeting was also held with senior officials of Afghan health department including Deputy and Minister of health.






