40TH FIMA COUNCIL MEETING AND FIMA-IMAM SCIENTIFIC MEETING TO BE HELD IN KL, MALAYSIA IN OCTOBER 2023

The organizing committee and IMA Malaysia leadership under the leadership of Dr. Yusri Musa has geared up and actively engaged in finalizing the arrangements of 40th FIMA council meeting and FIMA-IMAM scientific meeting to be held in Hotel Everly, Putrajaya, Malaysia from 24-29th October 2023.



The week long FIMA saga is starting from 24th October 2023 with pre-council FIMA Ex-Co meeting to discuss the FIMA Ex-Co report and arrangements for scientific meeting. The two day long marathon activity of FIMA council meeting will be held on 25th and 26th October 2023. The agenda includes adoption of minutes of last council meeting and presentation of Ex-Co report by the president of FIMA. The reports of executive directors and finance secretary will also be presented. The reports of individual IMAs and FIMA projects will be presented in the afternoon session and on day 2nd. The applications of new IMAs from Republic of Congo and to be admitted as Burundi members will be presented before the council for approval. The venue of 41st FIMA council meeting will also be decided.

The FIMA-IMAM scientific









meeting will be held on 27-29th October 2023. The main symposium during opening session is on "Muslim women: Empowerment in healthcare and nation building". Day two will start with a symposium on "Sports and heath: from sick care to healthcare". There will be sessions on NCD and climate change, Sacred to safe pilgrimage: what is next?, HPV related diseases: Prevention strategies, Future of relief work, NCD and marginalized populations. The final and third day has a treasure of information and knowledge to share with the delegates and includes sessions on, Obesity in new generation: NCD, Mental

health in children, are we facing a crisis?, NCD and aging population, protecting Atrial fibrillation patients with multiple co-morbidities.

Before the closing ceremony and presentation of awards, the concluding session would be chaired by the Hon'ble minister of health YT Zaliha Binti Mustafa and her talk on "Health reform agenda of Malaysia".

Besides these meetings and scientific session, a grand gala dinner and arrangements for sightseeing are also arranged for the delegates coming from all over the world.

9th August 2023

The First Aid training session conducted by the Islamic Medical Association Durban Branch for the students of the Islamic Relief Incubator of Dreams program, coordinated by the Young Leaders Academy, was successfully held on August 9, 2023. The event took place at the Suleman Lockhat Auditorium, located at the Mariam Bee Sultan Centre, on the occasion of Women's Day.

The training session was designed to equip participants with essential life-saving skills – how to perform 1st responder CPR and how to deal with a person choking. The primary objective was to empower participants with the knowledge and practical skills required to respond effectively during emergency situations. The event aimed to bridge the gap in first aid knowledge within the community and raise awareness about the importance of immediate and

correct response in critical situations.

Dr Mohamed Raiman, Specialist Anaesthesiologist and IMA Durban Branch Vice chairperson conducted the training with assistance of 4 volunteer medical students from the IMA KZN Student wing – Hassaan Motala, Gohar Kabir, Hamzah Osman and Ahmad Mohamed. The trainers employed a combination of theoretical knowledge, practical demonstrations, and hands-on practice using training mannequins.



AIMA Victoria CPR and defibrillator training


Saturday 15th July - Al-Taqwa Mosque, Truiganina, Melbourne
