

The Federation of Islamic Medical Associations (FIMA) has pledged to establish a Field Hospital near Gaza which can be shifted to Gaza when permitted. This 50 bedded hospital will be operated by FIMA healthcare professionals (HCP) from different member countries including Turkiye, Malaysia, Pakistan, UK, US and others. A large number of highly expert HCP have already volunteered their services.

FIMA is in the process of negotiating with different vendors in Turkiye for this purpose. The one time cost of procurement, transport and installation is approximately USD 4 Million. FIMA plans to operate this field hospital for one year period and then to donate to either Gaza or Egypt.

FIMA is requesting OIC to facilitate the permission from the Egyptian Government for this humanitarian medical initiative. Additionally, we are requesting the Egyptian Government to facilitate the passage of the various medical teams with visas and other required documents.

FIMA is the largest body of Muslim HCP in OIC, the Islamic Advisory Group (IAG). FIMA is a not-for-profit organisation registered in US since December 1981 and have special consultative status to the United Nation ECOSOC since 2005..

FIMA has been actively involved in humanitarian and medical relief in Gaza, Palestine since 7 October 2023, through our dedicated relief associates who have been operating there since 2009.

Al Khidmat Foundation (AKF) from Pakistan is the largest relief associate in the FIMA fraternity. AKP have been involved since Day 1 with humanitarian relief and



medical support in Gaza. Amongst others, their current projects include the following:

- 1. Collaboration with various NGO's in Gaza: amounting to USD 300,000 with another USD 300,000 planned for the next phase
- 90 tons of relief supplies airlifted via cargo Boeing to Egyptian Red Crescent (ERC) through El Arish airport, Egypt. It was received by the Palestine Red Crescent and passed across the borders
- 3. Another consignment of similar goods has been planned for next week
- 4. An MOU with Al Khair Al Misr and the Egyptian Food Bank for supply of relief goods to the value of USD 500,000 has been completed
- 5. A FIMA field hospital with an estimated cost of USD 2.5 million excluding freight and installation costs, and managed by the FIMA network of HCP
- 6. Bulk supplies via sea channel negotiated with the Seaport of Karachi to organize the continuous bulk supply of specific relief items
- 7. The acquisition of 10 fully equipped ambulances planned for delivery ASAP
- 8. Sponsorship for the care of orphans are in order
- 9. Sponsorship of students from Gaza studying in Pakistan will be borne by Al-Khidmat


Other affiliates of FIMA have already disbursed the amount of USD 680,000 for the following projects which have been completed or are undergoing:


- 1. The provision of safe clean and filtered water to the Internally Displaced Person (IDP) in the shelters. In Khan Younis e.g. Abed Allah Sham school, Khaled Al Hassan school
- 2. Baby kits: milk, diapers, wipes, baby food, baby cleanser, lotion etc
- 3. Food voucher project: Food hampers to value of USD50 VPM vouchers per family distributed to 800 families in Gaza City, or 100 families/day
- 4. Hot meals cooked, prepared and distributed to IDP, their families in Khan Younis, and to medical staff and patients in hospitals in Gaza City.
- 5. VPM Ambulances support emergency care with transporting of injured victims
- 6. Ops Ihsan is a collaboration between the Malaysian government and various NGO's airlifting relief supplies valued at USD 1,500,000
- 7. Fuel for charity hospitals and ambulances
- 8. Food baskets
- 9. Life saving medical supplies and surgical devices
- 10. Hot meals, about 1,000 meal daily
- 11. Cash assistance to IDP
- 12. Mobile medical clinics to decongest the hospitals
